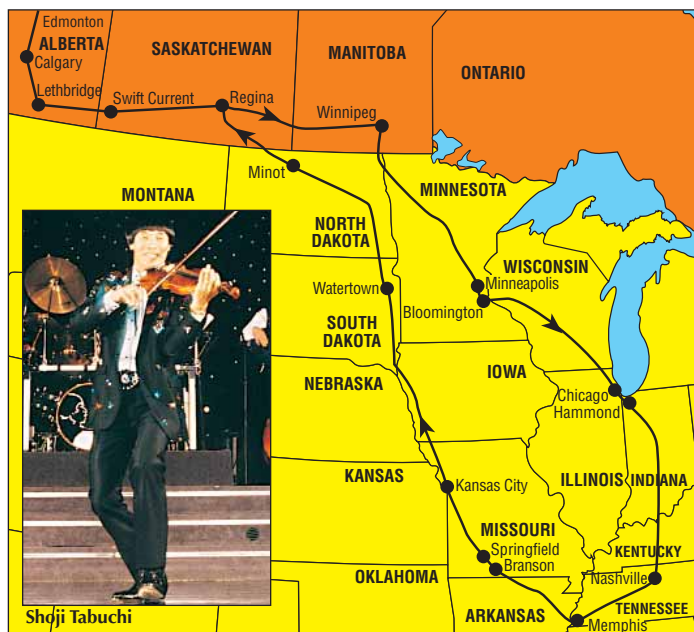

- 1** **EDMONTON to CALGARY to SWIFT CURRENT:** Your *Musical Journey* begins as you are welcomed aboard your deluxe coach in Edmonton. Travel south via Red Deer to Calgary meeting additional travelling companions enroute. A stop is made in Medicine Hat before crossing the Alberta/Saskatchewan border and arriving in Swift Current, Saskatchewan.

Then sit back for an evening at the GRAND OLE OPRY, the heart and soul of any Nashville visit. Celebrating its 85th Birthday this live radio broadcast enjoyed by thousands each weekend will be performed before your very eyes.
 - 6 7** **NASHVILLE:** Highlights today include stops at RYMAN AUDITORIUM, where the Grand Ole Opry originated, and the COUNTRY MUSIC HALL OF FAME – a museum dedicated to entertainers, composers and leaders of the country music industry. Nashville is famous for its many nightclubs – you have a free evening tonight if you wish to visit one.
 - 7 8** **NASHVILLE to MEMPHIS:** Humming a country tune, make your way to Hurricane Mills to visit LORETTA LYNN'S DUDE RANCH. Continue to Memphis, home of Beale Street, with its many jazz and blues clubs. Whether or not you are an Elvis fan, everyone wants to make a pilgrimage to GRACELAND, the Superstar's estate.
 - 8 9** **MEMPHIS to BRANSON:** (3 nights) Today you are on your way to America's hottest entertainment destination for three nights of fabulous

- 12 13** **KANSAS CITY to WATERTOWN:** Follow the fertile Missouri River Valley and overnight in Watertown, South Dakota.
